




## 2018 Grant Distribution

Annually the Catholic Foundation offers a competitive granting process to distribute a percentage of returns from our field of interest funds. Individuals or families, named or otherwise, can support these funds to benefit their communities today and for future generations.

In 2018, the inaugural year for distributions, we awarded \$88,500 in grants to southeastern Michigan parishes, schools and community nonprofit organizations. Twenty five grants were offered to 23 organizations in amounts up to \$5,000.
